

Hello,

I just wanted to give you all an update on Oisin, he was diagnosed with Leukaemia 3rd May and has started Chemotherapy which he will receive for the next 3 years, they have also put in a Hickman line that will also be in for the next 3 years but with the line Oisin will not have to be stuck with needles as much.

The treatment has a 90% success rate with kids which is very helpful but we will spend a lot of time in the hospital as he is very prone to infection, Oisin was let home on Tuesday but he got a temperature on Thursday so they took him back into hospital for tests and antibiotics and if he is well he will get home tomorrow or Sunday.

He will receive Chemo every Tuesday for the next 8 weeks and he has been getting Chemo injected into his spine, and he will lose his hair over the next few weeks, as you can image this has been a big shock for us and we have had a lot of changes to our lives and with Clare due our fourth child at the end of June we have to be careful with her, we are very thankful for interest prayers and support for our family at this time please keep us in prayer.
